

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
Finding and booking into ASPIRE workshops

- **No other** self-development activity, no matter how worthy, can be counted towards your ASPIRE Program.



Finding and booking into ASPIRE workshops

- Once you have booked into a workshop, there is nothing else for you to do but attend!
- The booking will automatically appear on your ASPIRE record and your attendance or absence will also be recorded by the workshop facilitator following the event.



Finding and booking into ASPIRE workshops

- Please respect the facilitators who prepare materials and prepare for certain numbers of participants in their workshops.
- If you're not able to attend, please cancel as early as possible and at the very least 48 hours prior to the workshop.



Please note!

- You **cannot use the same workshop twice** towards your ASPIRE Program record.
- Please read the description in the event listing **BEFORE** you book into a workshop. From time to time there is pre-work or a pre-requisite for attending a workshop.



Rules for ASPIRE workshops

- Please be on time! We reserve the right to deny a student access to the workshops if they arrive more than 10 minutes late.
- If you attend an online workshop, and the facilitator feels you have not participated actively, they reserve the right to mark you as absent, even though you have logged on.



Reflection and Employability Workshop

- Students completing the ASPIRE Platinum Program will need to attend a Reflection and Employability Workshop in July or October.
- During this workshop we help you to understand how to sell your ASPIRE Program achievement to prospective employers.

- Once you have completed your ASPIRE Program we will help you to add the workshops to your UniSA+ Award.
